



## Front Grill Swap

The following is a brief guide on how to swap the front grill.

A common mod for our cars is to replace the stock grill with either a Legana part or a TRD Grill. Either option, removing the grille can be tricky and can lead to broken tabs and frustration. Here is a step-by-step guide on how to carefully remove and replace a grill.

Here is the grille before image of the grill.



Remove the screw at the centre, just above the bonnet catch, remove the 4 screw/push plugs from the sides of the grill, just at the top inside edges of the head lights.

Note: Take them right out.



The plastic bumper tabs were really covered in road grime so I sprayed some silicon lube through the grille between the bumper tabs and grill. Get a long flat head screwdriver and push the tab down while lifting up and pushing the bottom of the grill, above each tab, towards the radiator.

The grill should pop off the tabs easily, takes a lot of wiggling but it happens!



Put the new grill on using the same directions as above in reverse.

Here is the end result.
